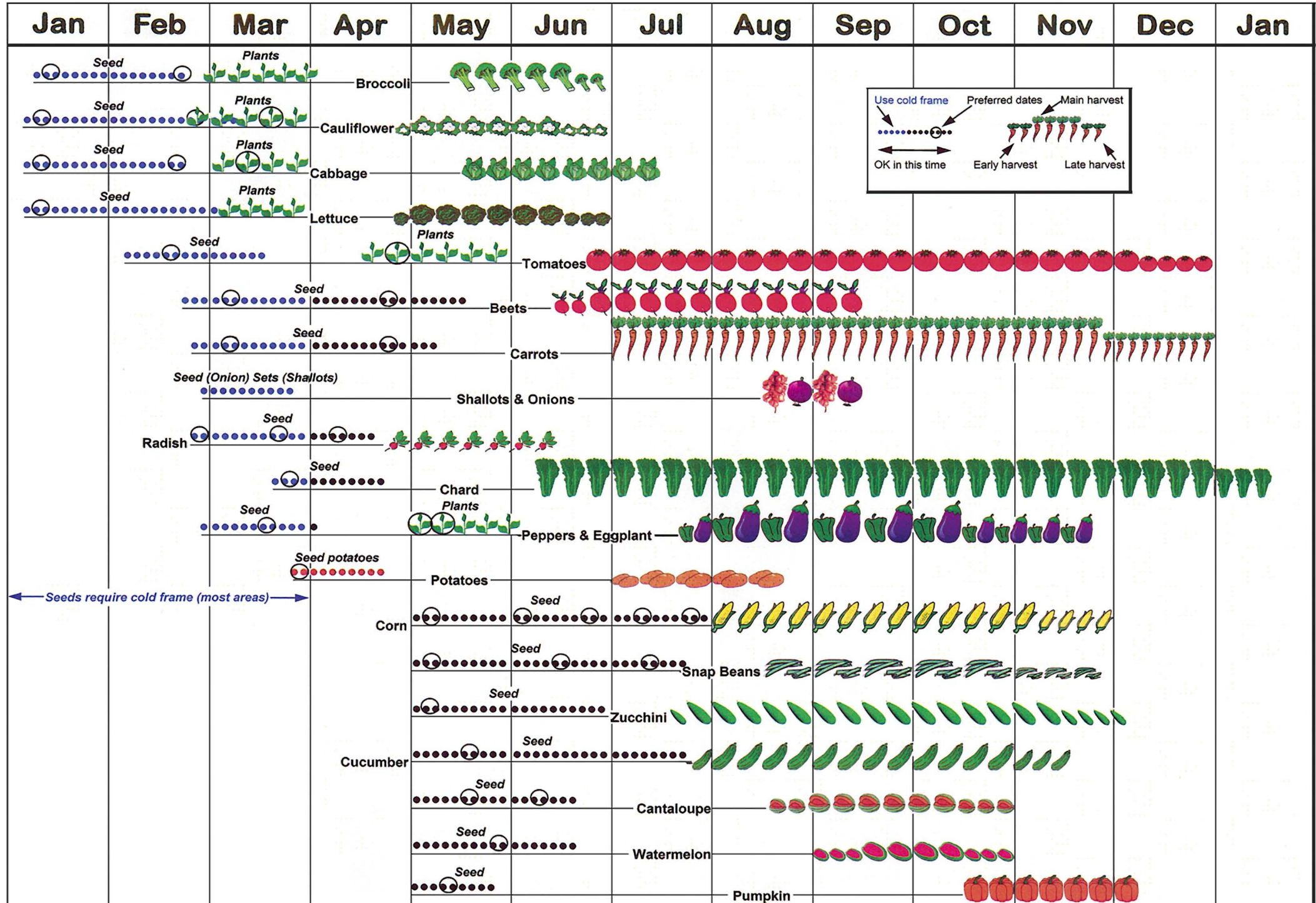
Winter/Spring

Winter/Spring Planting Guide

Planting and harvest dates are for a typical garden at 2000'. Adjust planting dates by about one week for each 1000' above or below 2000', earlier for lower elevations and later for higher. These are guidelines only. Microclimates can vary.

Foothill topography can be quite diverse. Official elevations for some areas are provided below for reference:

While weather can be unpredictable, these rules of thumb for last frost dates can be useful:

1000'	April 15
2000'	April 22
3000'	April 30
4000'	May 7
